The Land Question in Namibia: By revisiting the old boundaries, and address land issue in Namibia, and those whose land were confiscated should be returned to the owner.

Nation-building amidst gender-based violence, ethnic heterogeneity: Equity based on diversity, the need to develop flexible and accessible services to eliminate this gender based violence.

Government procurement processes of goods and services: Those have to be shared equally.

Corruption and Accountability: Corruption became a deadly virus that has to be eradicated by empowering independent institute which will be accountable for unfinished cases.

Decentralization: Devolution to Regional and Local councils: All Ministries should be decentralized in all 14 regions, to create jobs, about Devolution, we do delegate power from high ranked person to a lower ranked person.

What is your party's short and long-term vision for Namibia?

[Our short term goal] is to present a clear vision of where we are, what we do, and our target goals.

On a Long term is to do forestry plantation in the north and southern part of Namibia to save livestock and people. [Additionally, we are going to work in the area of] Food security and Job creation. Our short term goal is to have a development framework through our party manifesto.
